

Showcase Talking Points for Lead Chaperones to announce to students prior to unloading the bus

- Stay with your designated chaperone or leader.
- Restrooms will be available, ask your chaperone for permission.
- You will be given a pen and a Field Study Card. You will be turning in your completed
 card to your chaperone afterward.
- Put **your name** on your Field Study Card as soon as you receive it.
- Ask intelligent questions at each booth, write down what you learn in your card,
 identify preferred career clusters. This may be graded.
- If you get candy, put wrappers in your pocket or a trash can.
- There will be an announcement when there are 5 minutes remaining. Stay with the group. You may leave a different way than you came in.
- There will be students attending from other schools. Be respectful of others. Positively represent yourself and your school.
- Schools may add anything they deem important for students.
