

Guidelines for Chaperones 2025

- 1. Note your arrival time on the schedule. Please try to stay on schedule!
- 2. Check the total student **number**. If it has changed a lot, please let me know.
- 3. Prior to the Showcase, students should complete a career assessment and should know their top **3 Career Clusters**. This will help with IGPs later!

- 4. Follow the map to drop off in front, proceed through the building, and then to exit via the side. There will also be assistants inside to direct you.
- 5. Students will have approximately ½ hr outside and ½ hr inside with businesses.
- 6. Upon arrival, students will be giving a Showcase brochure. Included will be a **list of questions** for students to ask each business. Please be sure they are interacting!
- 7. Check to be sure students put their **name** on the field student brochure!
- 8. Review **proper etiquette**: speaking professionally, making eye contact, asking proper questions, not littering, staying with the group, etc.
- Be prepared to collect each of the booklets to save as your documentation of a structured field study.
- 10. Notify your PowerSchool person that each student who attended must be **recorded in PowerSchool** or you will not receive "credit" with the state for your efforts!
